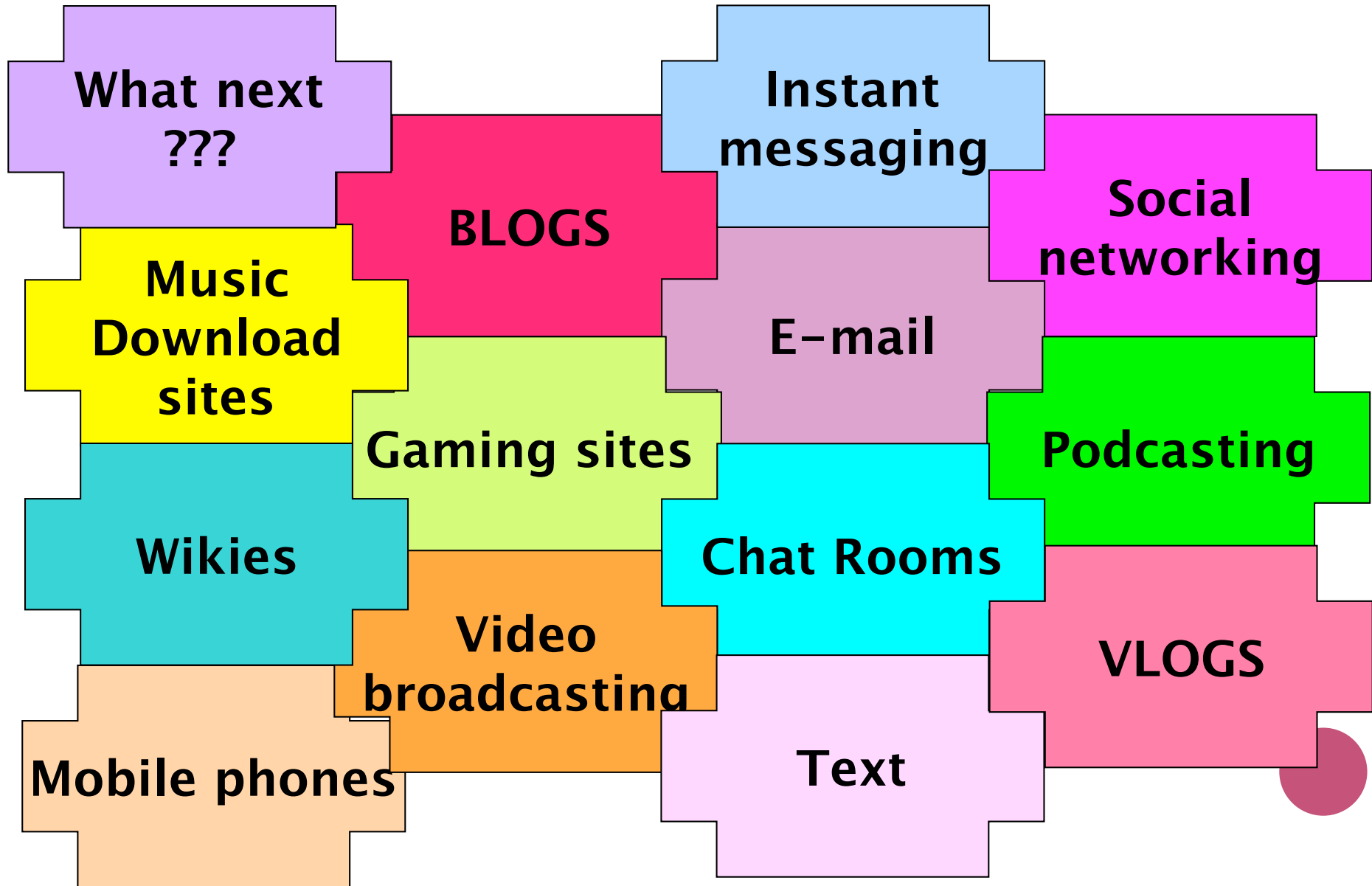


BENEFITS OF TECHNOLOGY FOR CHILDREN:

OFCOM REPORT 2014

- 71% of 5–15 year olds have access to a tablet computer at home.
- 88% of children ages 5–15 live in a household with access to the internet through a PC, laptop or netbook.
- 84% children aged 5–15 live in a household with a fixed or portable games console.



OFCOM REPORT 2014

 31% of children aged 5–15 have a smartphone. 2% of 5–7s, 20% of 8–11s, and 65% of 12–15s.

 11% of 3–4 year olds have a tablet computer, 23% of 5–7s, 34% of 8–11s

Devices in the bedroom

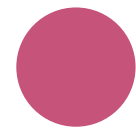
- 35% of 5–7s have a television in their bedroom.
- Games consoles are the second most common type of device in children's bedrooms, 10% of 3–4s, 27 of 5–7s and 44% of 8–11s.

3+		Violence - Game contains depictions of violence
7+		Discrimination - Game contains depictions of, or material which may encourage, discrimination
12+		Sex - Game depicts nudity and/or sexual behaviour or sexual references
16+		Drugs - Game refers to or depicts the use of drugs
18+		Fear - Game may be frightening or scary for young children
		Bad Language - Game contains bad language
