

Please read our information sheet carefully to find out what is going on in your child's class for this half term.

Literacy

One of the key focuses for this half term will be to use a range of adjectives, adverbs, expanded noun phrases and powerful verbs in our writing. To develop such features, we will complete a Big Write linked to creating a description of a superhero of our choice.

Moreover, we will be looking at different styles/features of poetry, write our own and recite these with expression and intonation. We aim to present some of our amazing work in an assembly in November.

Science, History, Geography, Art and ICT (IPC)

In Science, we will learn about the importance of the digestive system and our teeth.

The study of History will give us an understanding of British History, with the focus being on Roman Britain (invasions, resistance and Romanisation of Britain. We will incorporate ICT into our learning through this.

We will also look at the work of a range of painters, including Henri Matisse.

Geography will enable us to look at the UK more closely in terms of physical and human features. This will link with our focus topic of Land, Sea and Sky.

Numeracy

This term we will explore how to tell the time to the exact minute. This will build on what we have already learnt in Year 3.

Furthermore, we will consolidate our knowledge of addition and subtraction with written methods and study doubling and halving 3-digit numbers.

In addition, we will work with different fractions, understand place value and decimals, convert measurements and use this to present, interpret and collect data.

Physical Education (P.E)

In addition to the Tottenham Hotspurs Foundation running P.E sessions, this term we will focus on Hockey which will be led by the class teacher. This will be every Wednesday. Please remind children to bring P.E Kits.

Assemblies

We enjoy assemblies every day. Please join us every Friday at 2.55pm to celebrate our progress and achievements across the school.

RE

This half term we are learning about a range of different faiths, including Judaism and a closer study of **Christmas**. We will think about what Christmas means to Christians.

French

We are very fortunate to welcome Mrs Houghton to our school. She will also be delivering French lessons to our bright children.

Reading

This term we will focus on the book called 'The Famous Five', with class activities including vocabulary work and skills such as summarising, questioning and evaluating parts of the book.
